



Competitors,

The EHV-1 Virus situation has prompted the Carolina Horse Park (CHP) to require all horses entering the Park to have a 72-hour Veterinary Certificate, effective immediately. Upon entering the grounds via the stabling entrance, you will be asked to provide our attendants with your certificate(s). Should you arrive after hours you are required to deliver your certificates to the show office no later than 9am the following morning with no exceptions. Further, we ask that you check your horses' temperatures twice daily while at the Park. Should your horse register a temperature of 101.5 degrees or greater you must contact the Treating Veterinarian through the show office immediately.

The CHP Treating Veterinary team will be monitoring barns throughout the weekend to ensure the safety of all equine athletes. The CHP reserves the right to ask any horse with symptoms or a sustained temperature above 102 degrees to immediately leave the property.
